### **Culinary Corner**

Hello,

I would like to start out by welcoming our newest culinary team members, Stephanie, Olivia, and Elaina they're a great addition to Sterling Pointe and have done an awesome job!! I would also like to thank my entire staff, all of you are awesome, and I cannot thank you all enough for a great job you do every single day!

Let's talk State Fair food and these are items you can make at home very easily. The corn dog on a stick we won't call it by the name at the Fair, but all we need to do is buy some wooden sticks to put our favorite hot dog on, I prefer all beef hot dogs, next we will slide the hot dog on the stick and set aside. We are going to need to make cornbread batter using corn muffin mix. I do not follow the directions on the box I just add water and stir until the batter is nice and thick and should not drip off the hot dog. Heat vegetable oil or canola which ever you prefer in a stock pot until temperature reaches 350 degrees, dip hot dog into corn batter and place into oil do not let go of the end of the stick until batter has become somewhat cooked. Cook until desired color golden brown and enjoy! The next one we can make using the same batter and technique is the cheese on a stick. First we will take block cheese what ever kind you like and cut a long hot dog shaped piece and place it on the stick. Dip cheese in corn muffin batter and fry in oil until desired color on outside is achieved, the inside should be melting and gooey, enjoy!!






# Star Resident of the Month
